CEF was founded in 2006 with a mission of funding innovative programs that give all Coastside public school students an opportunity to thrive. Since then, we have worked with the community to build an approximate \$3 million endowment that will benefit students today and in the future. Through our endowment and fundraising efforts, we are able to allocate hundreds of thousands of dollars per year to all public schools in the Cabrillo Unified School District. To date, CEF has allocated more than \$1 million to CUSD schools, serving more than 3,200 Coastside students.

Funding Programs for Impact

With the support of individual donors and businesses, we continue to allocate funding to important educational programs that help Coastside children excel in the classroom and beyond.

We are proud of the results of our 2018-19 allocations, including:



Funding a credentialed 5th grade science teacher, benefiting every elementary school in the district.



Granting more than \$10,000 in Innovation Grants to faculty and students to inspire and support creativity.



Partnering with The Big Lift to ensure students are able to read proficiently by third grade.



Extending the effectiveness of the AVID program in conjunction with CUSD by funding 6th and 12th grade participation. In 2017/2018 73% of AVID participants met UC/CSU requirements compared to 53% who did not participate.


